



ALCOHOL, DRUG AND BANNED SUBSTANCES POLICY

Canterbury Ice Hockey Association (CIHA)

The Canterbury Ice Hockey Association prohibits the use of all recreational and performance enhancing drugs and substances by all association members, guests and visitors to the association events and venues.

Areas covered by this policy include, changing rooms, playing surface and car park.

Any person found to be under the influence of illegal drugs and substances or whose behaviour is impaired by alcohol will be asked to leave the event premises immediately and may be suspended from the Association for an indefinite period.

The consumption of alcohol at the Alpine Ice Sports Centre is limited to the downstairs bar/café and the spectator area surrounding the ice surface.
